Aims & To develop key skills through the experience of work.

Objectives: To gain an insight into the work of the ambulance and rescue service.

Key Tasks:

Students should be aware that because of the nature of the work a high degree of shadowing / observation will be necessary. Students will be given a tour and full induction into the workings of the ambulance station on their first day. Depending on the work load student may spend time observing the different areas of work, this can include the control room, transporting non emergencies to hospital / treatment centres mainly elderly or housebound sick, assisting in the healthcare shop and the administration department where, with training, may assist with certain tasks such as photocopying and faxing.*IT SHOULD BE APPRECIATED BY ALL PARTIES (STUDENTS AND PARENTS) THAT BY THE VERY NATURE OF AMBULANCE WORK, STUDENTS MAY BE EXPOSED TO SIGHTS AND SITUATIONS THAT MAY BE UPSETTING*

Over 18 year old students may be able to observe first tier ambulance work. If possible, time and staff permitting student may visit The Flying Christine ambulance boat (in harbour & with life jacket.)
