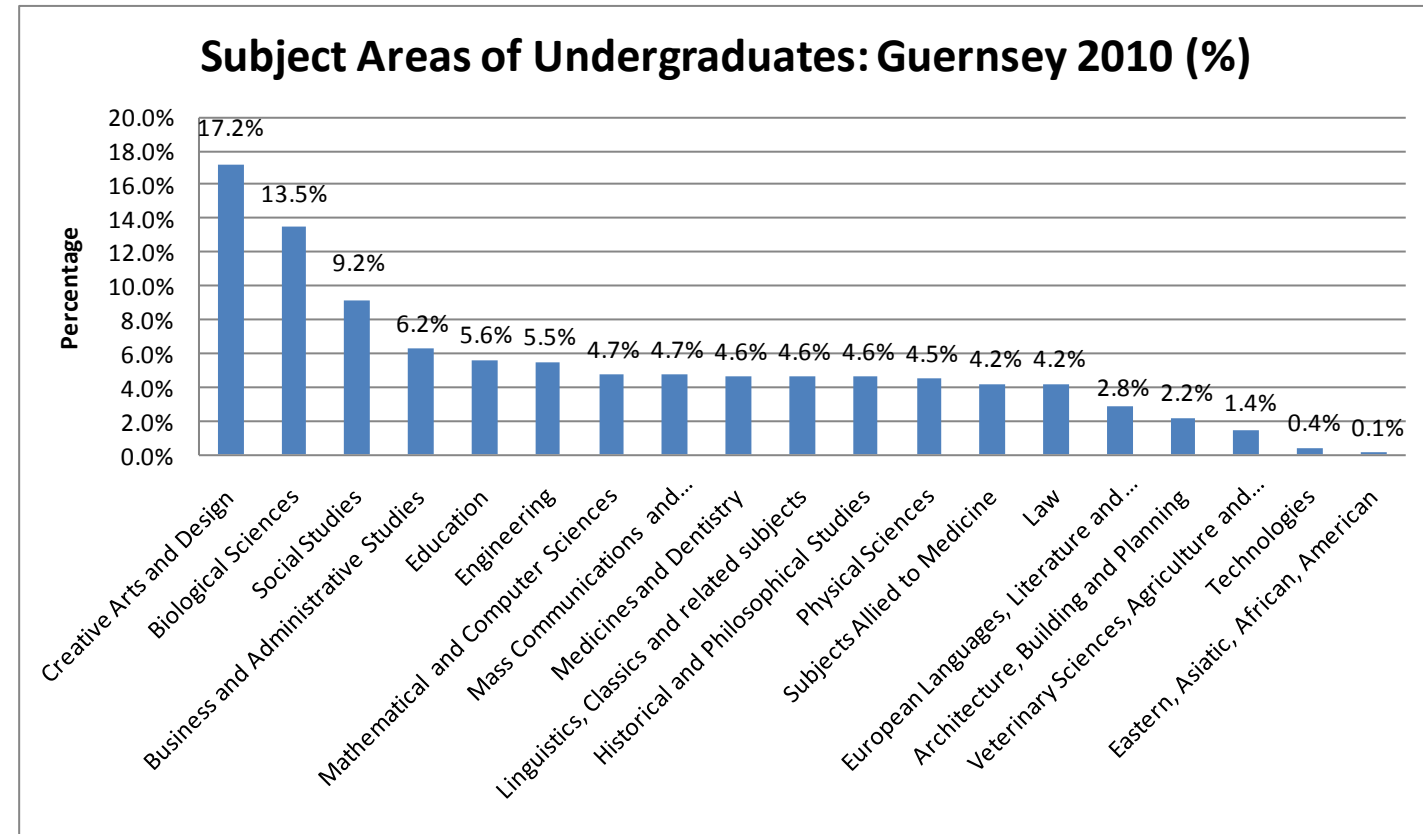


Higher Education

39% (178 students) of year 13 leavers joined Higher Education in 2010 at 170+ different Universities in the UK.

The graph below shows what they are studying:



There are currently more than 800 Guernsey students in Higher Education across all year groups. The south coast Universities remain a popular choice.

School Leaver Destinations Report 2010

KEY FINDINGS

Year 11

- Increase in students entering post 16 full time education
- More students in education and work based training (which includes States Apprenticeship Scheme)

Year 12

- Same number seeking employment after Year 12 study as in previous years
- A small decrease in numbers of those leaving education and becoming NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training)

Year 13

- The number of year 13 students entering HE is the same as in previous years
- Slightly more students taking Gap Years
- More leavers entered employment than last year

Each year more than 1700 16-18 year olds decide whether to enter employment or continue in education.

The Careers Service tracks as many of these school/college leavers as possible. The destinations recorded are an essential piece of labour market information and invaluable in supporting careers education and guidance.

Post—16 Education

In 2010, 79% (571 students) of Year 11 leavers remained in full time education (75% in 2009, 71% in 2008)

- 257 students are studying A levels at the Sixth Form Centre
- 172 students are studying BTEC/Vocational qualifications at the College of Further Education

In 2010, 85% of Year 12 leavers (448 students) remained in education

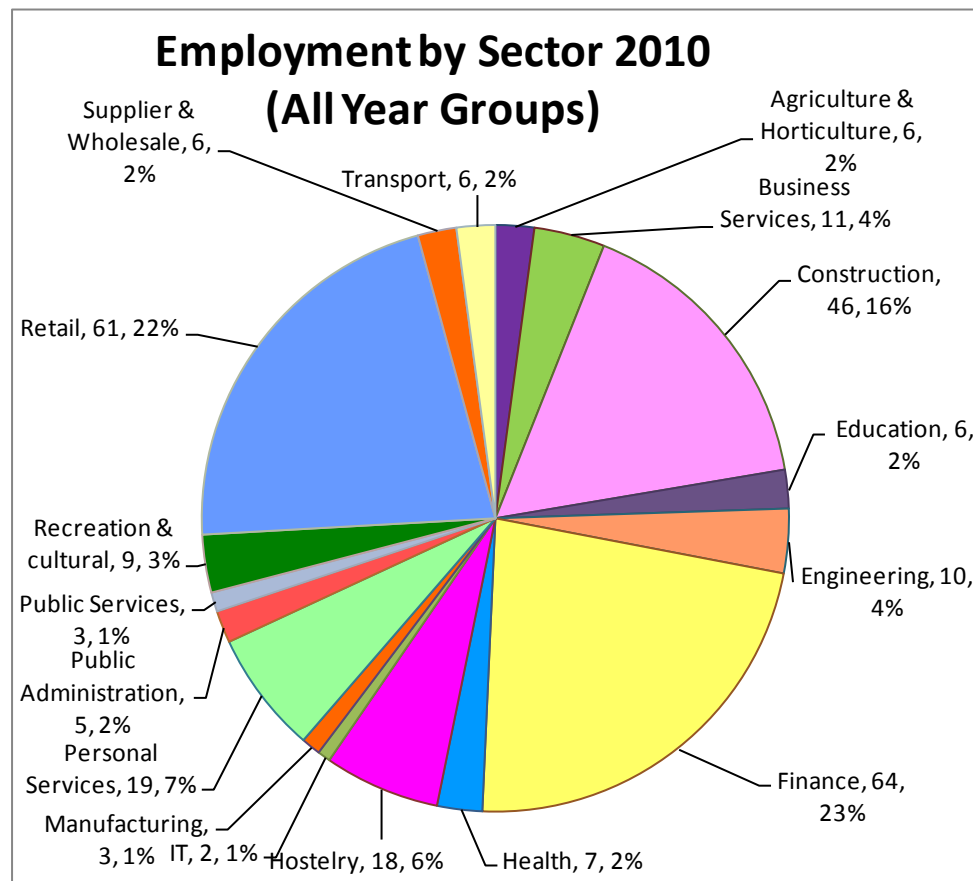
- 210 in the Sixth Form Centre
- 126 in the College of Further Education

In 2010, of Year 13 leavers:

- ◇ 39% (178) entered a Higher Education course
- ◇ 14% entered a Further Education course
- ◇ 10% took a gap year

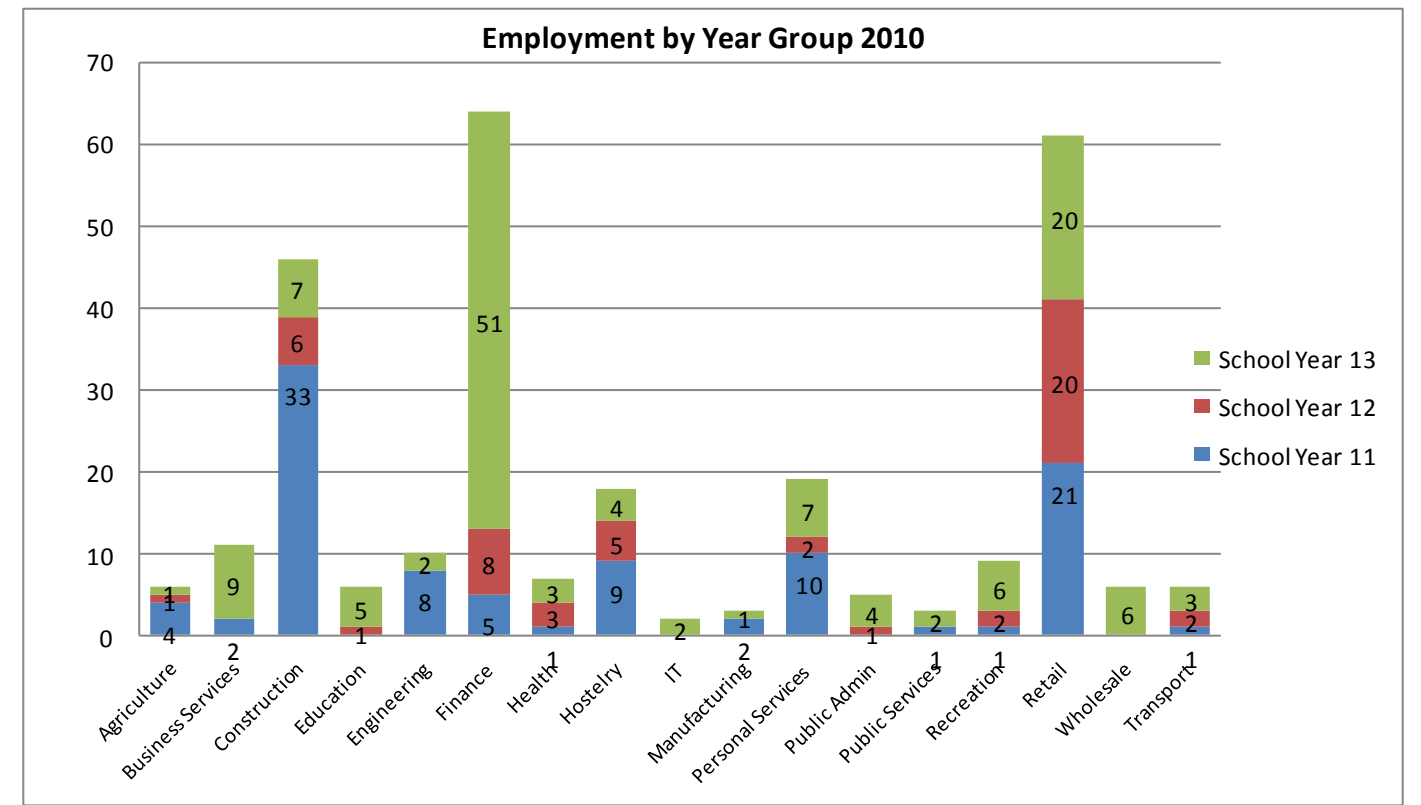
Employment and Work Based Training

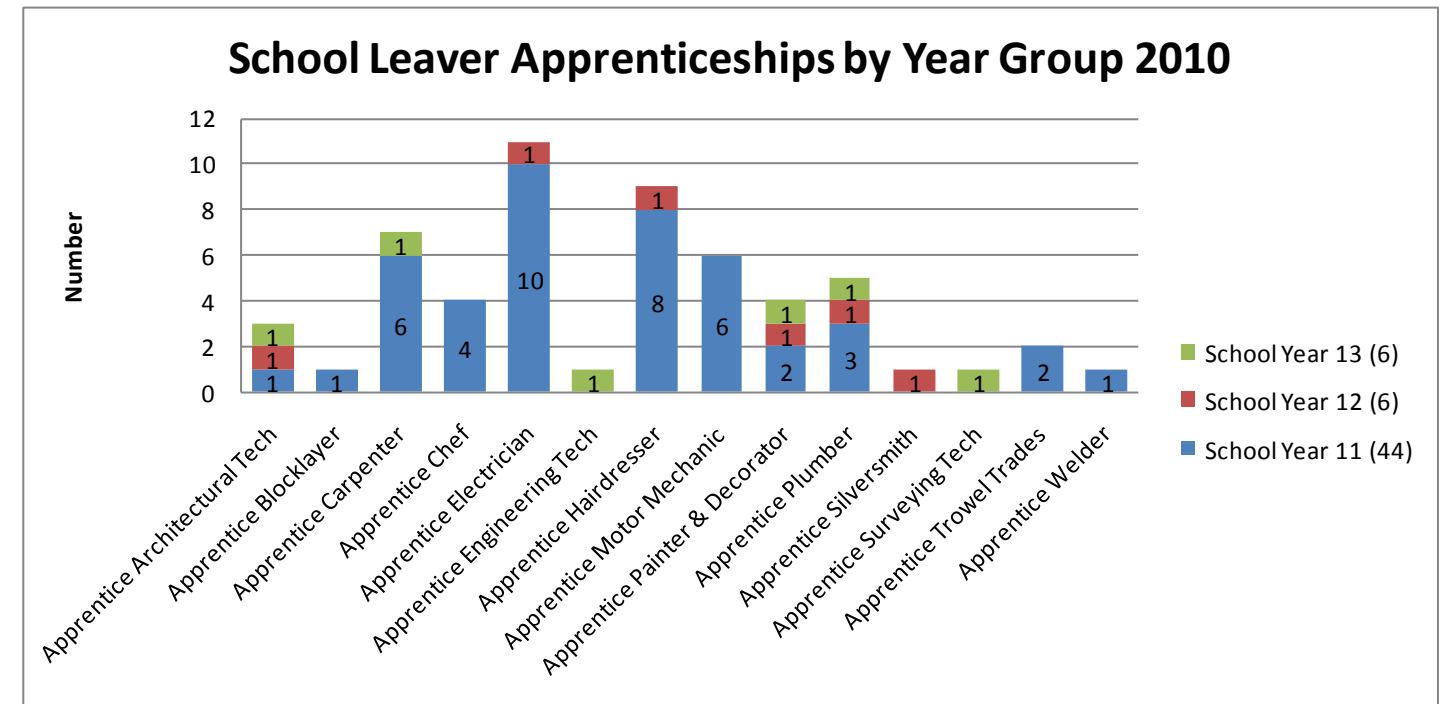

States Apprenticeships Scheme

In 2010:

- Year 11 leavers: 44 joined an Apprenticeship
- Year 12 leavers: 6 joined an Apprenticeship
- Year 13 leavers: 6 joined an Apprenticeship



Not in Education, Employment or Training

In 2010, 1721 students completed year 11, year 12 or year 13. Of these, 74 (4%) were Not in Employment, Education or Training.
